

MACOUPIN COUNTY BOARD  
ORDINANCE No. 2011,01

**An Ordinance Amending Section 3 of County Ordinance 2010.04, Providing For Direction of Funds Received from Penalties Associated with Absenteeism from School by Students Under Age 18 and For Providing Severability and an Effective Date**

WHEREAS, the Macoupin County Board adopted Ordinance 2010.04 which by purpose seeks to take appropriate action to cause a reduction in absenteeism from school by students under the age of 18 in Macoupin County; and

WHEREAS, the County Board was made aware by the Macoupin County State's Attorney's Office that the original ordinance, Ordinance 2010.04, did not specifically state where proceeds from fines were to be directed once imposed; and

WHEREAS, the County Board recognizes the problem and deems it to be in the best interest of increasing transparency of depositing funds collected by the county and streamlining county procedure so as to eliminate all possible error to amend Macoupin County Ordinance 2010.04; therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board that Macoupin County Ordinance 2010.04 shall be amended as follows:

Section 3 shall be amended to add the following:

(d) Any fine imposed on a Macoupin County Student in violation of this Ordinance and collected by the County shall be deposited into the General Fund.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage in the manner prescribed by law.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the underlying Ordinance as all other provisions in the Ordinance shall remain in full force.
