WHEREAS, Michael Allan Zippay, Sr. was a 1951 graduate of Mt. Olive High School, served his Country in the United States Army, and played minor league baseball for the Mt. Vernon Kings and Mattoon Indians; and

WHEREAS, Michael Allan Zippay, Sr. served as Macoupin County Treasurer from 1970 to 1994; and

WHEREAS, in addition to his service as Macoupin County Treasurer, Michael Allan Zippay, Sr. served on the Macoupin County Board from 1995 until his passing; and

WHEREAS, Michael Allan Zippay, Sr. proudly represented County Board District 4 including a portion of the City of Benld, the Village of White City, the Village Eagarville, the Village of Sawyerville, unincorporated Mt. Olive Township, portions of unincorporated Cahokia and the City of Mt. Olive; and

WHEREAS, as a member of the Finance Committee, Michael Allan Zippay, Sr. and his knowledge of County government helped lead the Macoupin County Board through unprecedented fiscal challenges; and

WHEREAS, Michael Allan Zippay, Sr. is fondly remembered by his colleagues on the County Board not only for his knowledge of County government, but for his desire to Mt. Olive and all of Macoupin County for over four decades; therefore


